## **Quick Information About LMS Cheerleading!**

Thank you for your interest in the LMS cheerleading program. Our goal this year is to choose a LMS cheerleading squad that shows outstanding ability and spirit, and appropriately represents our school and reflects a spirit of cooperation and unity.

Below are important dates and information that you will need to know!

- 1. You must return your physical, teacher evaluation, your application and your permission form to Coach Prescott by April 10th.
- 2. School attendance and discipline records will be checked for excessive problems.
- 3. Candidates must clear all financial obligations to the cheerleaders and/or the school before trying out.
- 4. Candidates will wear appropriate clothing for clinic and tryouts. Jewelry is not permitted in any form. Solid <u>red shorts</u> and a solid <u>white shirt</u> are to be worn during the tryout on April 18th.
- 5. Hair that touches the shoulders is to be pulled back in a ponytail.
- 6. Fingernails must not extend past the end of the finger.
- 7. No body piercing of any kind may be worn, during tryouts, practices, games or competitions.
- 8. No gum, candy or food will be allowed during the clinic or tryouts. (water or PowerAde welcome. NO SODAS!!)
- 9. Phones will be kept put up during tryouts until the end of the day.
- 10. Each cheerleading candidate will perform a small group dance, cheer and chant learned at the clinic. Each candidate will also perform three jumps (1 toe touch, 1 double toe touch and a jump of choice). If the candidate is able to do any tumbling, this will be performed also.
- 11. Tryouts will be April 18th. The judges' scores will determine the candidates to make the squad.
- 12. Tryout clinics will be CLOSED. NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED IN THE GYM DURING THE WEEK!
- 13. If you make the team, you must attend a mandatory sidelines camp on July 12-13 and a mandatory choreography camp on June 26-28.
- 14. <u>A \$300 deposit will be due June 1st. Failure to pay this deposit will result in dismissal from the team.</u>
- 15. Dead week dates for vacation planning purposes are May 27-June 2nd and July 1-7. There will be no practice or camp during those weeks.
