LMS House System

- **In combination with our positive rewards behaviour program, LMS has a House System where each student belongs to a specific group.**
- **Students work to earn points for their House in order to win incentives on a weekly and quarterly basis. Points are awarded through the PBIS app and known as 'Warrior Ones'. Individual student recognitions among houses are highlighted and rewarded.**

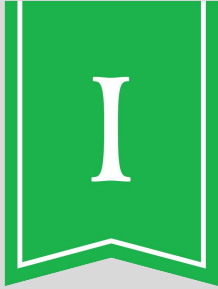




AMISTAD™

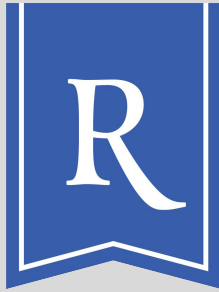




ISIBINDI™

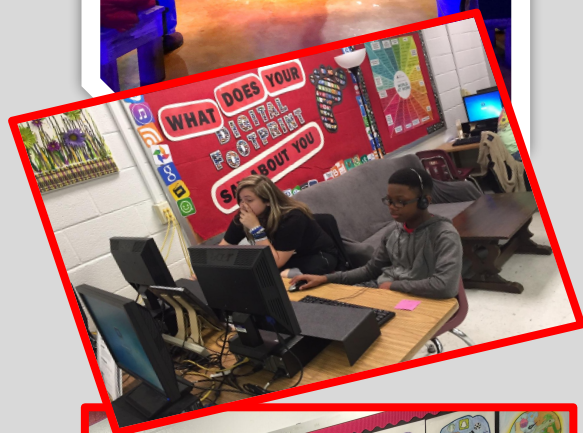

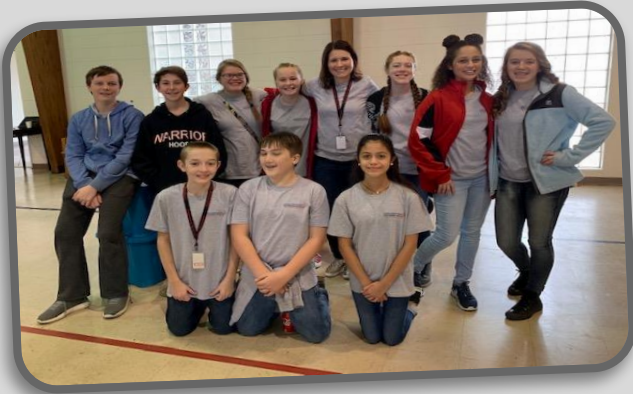
