

LMS House System

- In combination with our positive rewards behaviour program, LMS has a House System where each student belongs to a specific group.
- Students work to earn points for their House in order to win incentives on a weekly and quarterly basis. Points are awarded through the PBIS app and known as 'Warrior Ones'. Individual student recognitions among houses are highlighted and rewarded.





ALTRUISMO

The black house are known as "The Givers." They care deeply about lifting others up, but they also maintain a fiercely competitive spirit and pride. Mr. Chastain's house, Altruismo members can be heard throughout the halls doing their call and response of "ATRU - ISMO!" A friendly rival of Reveur, Altruismo always finished every 9 weeks strong, making the upcoming school year feel like it is going to be Altruismo's year.





MISTA

The red house, whose name means "Friendship." A group of individuals that are quiet but powerful, they are known most for their kindness of heart. 
